- Each National Scout Organization shall send a maximum of 3 patrols.
- Each patrol shall consist of 8/9 Scouts & one Unit leader.
- Scouts shall be 11-18 years & Rover Scouts shall be 18 -26 years old
- Unit Leaders Should be more than 18 years.
- Each Contingent shall appoint a Contingent Leader in addition to unit leaders.

Event platform of the Global Cultural Jamboree

- Participants will be registered for the Global Cultural Jamboree through the registration platform.
- Participants log onto www.gcj.scout.lk on the 16th, 17th and 18th of July 2021 and enter valid Jamboree Username, issued upon registration to access the Jamboree Virtual Campsite.
- Participants can select the desired activity and participate by joining the online platforms such as Zoom, YouTube Live, Kahoot! etc. or join the recordings of past events.
- Upon the completion of activities, an event code will be issued by the activity moderator. Participants are required to note down this code and enter it in the Jamboree Certification platform between the 18th and 21st of July 2021 to be eligible for the Jamboree Award.
