1. PRESENTATION

The 1st National Seminar on Interreligious Dialogue of the Scouts of Brazil constitutes a strategic space for reflection, training, and institutional articulation, aimed at strengthening respectful coexistence, dialogue, and cooperation among different religious traditions within the scope of Brazilian Scouting.

The event aims to align concepts and practices related to Interreligious Dialogue, in accordance with the values of Scouting, promoting educational action that respects the diversity of beliefs and encourages a culture of peace in the different territories of the country.

Its main objectives are:

- To consolidate understanding of the fundamentals of Interreligious Dialogue in Scouting, in light of the principles, values, and guiding documents of the União dos Escoteiros do Brasil and the World Organization of the Scout Movement;
- To promote strategic alignment between the national and regional levels regarding guidelines and practices related to Interreligious Dialogue;
- To train regional and local leaders and teams to develop and implement educational actions that promote respect for religious diversity and fraternal coexistence in different local contexts;
- To foster the integration and strengthening of a National Network for Interreligious Dialogue, reinforcing the institutional commitment to inclusion, mutual respect, and peacebuilding.

2. DATE

May 16th and 17th, 2026 (Saturday and Sunday).

3. LOCATION

Scout Camp of the Federal District, located at **SCES Lot 3, Section 3 (opposite AABB), Brasília - DF, 70200-003.**

THE CITY OF BRASÍLIA

Furthermore, the city is full of works by artists such as Athos Bulcão, Burle Marx, Alfredo Ceschiatti, Marianne Peretti, and Bruno Giorgi, making it an unparalleled place. Brasília is so surprising that it was the first modern city and the newest to be declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1987, at only 27 years old. The city is also rich in natural resources, with many waterfalls, caves, and lagoons, perfect environments for ecological tours and outdoor sports. Take advantage of your visit to get to know, discover, and be enchanted by Brasília. You will see that the Capital of Brazil will surprise you too.

OPTIONS FOR GETTING TO BRASÍLIA

- **Car:** There are several route options for visitors from all over the country. As Brasília is located in the center of Brazil, the capital is a transit point between various destinations in the country. For those planning to go by car, the main access highways are BRs 040, 060, 020 and 070.
- **Bus:** The Brasília Bus Terminal is located at the end of Asa Sul (SMAS, Trecho 4, Conjunto 6/5 – Asa Sul), near Park Shopping and next to the Shopping Station metro station.
- **Plane:** Brasília International Airport President Juscelino Kubitschek, with service from several airlines.

4. PLANNED PROGRAM

The National Seminar on Interreligious Dialogue will have its program detailed in Bulletin 2 and will be based on the guidelines of World Scouting, especially the document Interreligious Dialogue Guidelines for Scouting, as well as the institutional documents and policies of the União dos Escoteiros do Brasil.

The program will include, in an integrated way:

- The Educational Project of the União dos Escoteiros do Brasil;
- The National Policy of the Educational Program, considering the responsibilities of the different levels of the organization;
- The principles of Interreligious Dialogue in Scouting, according to the guidelines of World Scouting;
- National Policy on Diversity and Inclusion;
- The processes of Adult Management, aligned with the Educational Program and leadership training;
- Confessional Ceremonies according to the orientation of each participant and possibilities (offer of religious leaders, volunteers and other needs).

The seminar venue will be open for registration starting at 7 PM on May 15, 2026 (Friday). The opening ceremony will be at 9 AM on May 16, 2026 (Saturday). The closing ceremony is scheduled for 12 PM on May 17, 2026 (Sunday).

5. REGISTRATION

Registration will be open from **March 5, 2026, until 6 PM on May 5, 2026**, to all members of the Scouts of Brazil, over 18 years of age, with current institutional registration, in the following category:

Participants: All members of the União dos Escoteiros do Brasil, with current institutional registration, whose payment of the registration fee will entitle them to participate in all activities scheduled for the seminar. Registration includes coffee breaks, meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner), badge and event insignia.

Limit of places: 100 registered participants

International Participants: Participation is subject to a minimum quorum of 40 registered Brazilian participants.

6. FOOD

Food will be provided on-site, including the following meals:

- May 16, 2026 - two (2) coffee breaks, one (1) lunch and one (1) dinner;
- May 17, 2026 - one (1) breakfast and one (1) coffee break.

7. PARTICIPATION AND REGISTRATION FEE

Interested international participants must express their interest to the União dos Escoteiros do Brasil via email at internacional@escoteiros.org.br.

Registration Fee: US\$ 40.00 (forty US dollars), payable in full at the time of registration.

8. TRANSPORTATION

Transportation and travel to the event venue are the responsibility of each participant. The seminar venue is located in the Club Sector area, and the best way to get there is by using ride-hailing services or taxis.

9. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation may be provided at the Scout Camp School of the Federal District, in camping mode, with each participant allowed to bring their own tent and other personal overnight equipment.

The site has adequate infrastructure, including bathrooms with showers and sanitary facilities, ensuring appropriate hygiene and comfort conditions for participants.

Alternatively, participants may choose to stay in hotels in Brasília – DF, as well as on temporary rental platforms such as Airbnb, with the choice, costs and arrangements being the sole responsibility of each participant.

10. GENERAL CONDITIONS REGARDING REGISTRATION

10.1 REGISTRATION DEADLINE

The event organizers are working to welcome all participants with great care and to ensure that the 1st National Interreligious Dialogue Seminar offers unforgettable memories, learning experiences, and the experience of Scouting brotherhood. Therefore, registrations will be accepted until **6 PM on May 5, 2026**.

11. SAFE FROM HARM

Scout events, at all levels of the União dos Escoteiros do Brasil, must respect the values contained in our Scout Promise and Law, as well as the guidelines contained in the National Safe from Harm Policy. The event will operate respecting this important policy, a priority in our institution. Safe from Harm means establishing an environment that promotes and supports the well-being of children, adolescents, young people and adults, ensuring the expression of their individualities, while seeking to prevent potentially abusive practices to their physical and mental health.
